Re: Passion Play and SVP fundraiser – Non-Uniform Day - Friday 14th February

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to inform you about an exciting fundraising event the Sixth Form Head Student Team will be hosting on Friday 14th February. We would like to invite all students to participate in a Non-Uniform Day. On this day, students are encouraged to wear their own clothes. To take part, we kindly ask for a donation of £1 per student, which can be paid through Parent Pay by Friday 14th February.

A reminder that usual school uniform rules apply with regards to make-up, hair colour and jewellery, and shorts/skirts shorter than mid-thigh and ripped jeans are prohibited. Students should still be dressed appropriately to engage in their learning for the day. If students are due to have PE on Friday, they will need to have their PE kit with them to change into on the day. Feel free to engage them in choosing their outfits but remind them that participation is entirely optional. We want every student to feel comfortable and included. Students who do not wish to participate should attend school in their full school uniform.

The funds raised from this event will contribute to the Passion Play put on for the whole school by the current Year 13's. The other half of the money will go to SVP. We kindly request your support in spreading the word about this event with your children.
