Re: Results' Day - Year 11

GCSE results' day is **Thursday 21st August 2025** and students can collect results from BH1 from 8am or access results via Go 4 Schools at 9am. Students and their family can enter the school through the reception entrance on the corner of Milton and Canewdon Rd. Parking will be available on school site via the Canewdon Road delivery gate.

If students are not available on results day, a representative can collect results on their behalf. Students who are not available on results day will need to send an e-mail (from their school email account) to our Examinations Officer, Ms Brown Exams@stbernards.southend.sch.uk giving permission for a named representative to collect the results on their behalf. The representative must bring a form of ID of themselves, which they will need to show on the day to collect the results. We regret that we cannot release results unless we have this confirmation. Any results not collected by the end of the day on the 21st will be posted out to the address that we have on file for the student at school. Could you please ensure that any changes to address or contact details are notified to the school office before the end of term.

If you are unable to collect results you can view your results via Go 4 Schools, please ensure that you have checked your access is working. Should you need to reset or require any other guidance for Go 4 Schools please email Mrs Johnson on bjo@stbernards.southend.sch.uk. Please could you ensure that you have contacted us if you have any logging on issues **by Monday 14th July 2025**. Mrs Phillips, our careers advisor will be available on Friday 22nd August from 9am – 12 and Ms Brown, our exams officer will be available on Friday 22nd August from 8.30- 3.30pm to offer any advice students may need.

Confirming your Sixth Form place/Seeking advice:

Enrolment for St Bernard's High School 6th form will take place on Thursday 21st August 8am – 10.30am. You must meet the grade requirements for your chosen subjects as set out on our website to be able to be offered your place. You will have the opportunity to enrol and make any amendments to your subject choices on results day. **Please ensure that you speak to a member of staff before leaving to confirm your plans or to ask for further advice.**

If your plans have changed e.g. where the course or Sixth Form entry criteria have not been met, you will need to speak to a member of staff who will support you in finding a place at another institution. External students should arrive to enrol in person at 10.30am on Thursday 21st August.

The school will be open for any 6th form enrolment enquiries on:

Friday 22nd August 9am – 12pm. We will have a photographer on site and hope to capture the students' success. On behalf of all the teachers and tutors of Year 11, I wish your child the very best of luck in their examinations. This is a year group who have faced considerable challenges during their Secondary Education, and it has been a privilege to see their confidence, resilience and maturity develop.
